Taliparamba Co.Operative Hospital Society was registered under the Co-operative department Government of Kerala with Reg.No.C.1468 during the year 1998. The hospital started functioning in a rented building on 09.02.2001. The Area of operation of the hospital society is entire Kannur district and the registered office is at Taliparamba. The hospital was shifted to new building on 01.04.2002. It is a 300 bedded hospital. It provides services in all departments. It is a non- profit organization providing cost effective health care services to people in Taliparamba and nearby areas in Kannur. It is under the leadership of President and board of directors. Taliparamba Co-Operative College of nursing is functioning in a fully furnished building near karimbam bridge. The parent hospital of the college is Taliparamba Co–Operative hospital.

Government / General merit seats:- GM seats are those seats set apart for the students allotted by the Government following the guidelines of INC, KNMC and University.

Management seats:- Management seats are those seats set apart for the eligible candidates selected from the online applications received against the notification by management based on the marks in qualifying examination. Rank list will be prepared based on the marks obtained in 12th Examination on physics, chemistry, biology and English. Rank list will be published in the website and admission will be done from the list.

General Information

- University Examination shall be conducted at the end of each semester.
- Internal assessment through sessional exams, Seminars, Assignments, Projects, Clinical evaluation, internal practical examination etc.
- 50% marks for the internal assessment is mandatory for appearing the University examination.
- Candidates must secure 80% attendance in theory and practical in each subject in order to appear for the University examination.
- 100% attendance in clinical practice must be acquired before the award of the degree as per Indian Nursing Council / University guidelines.
- Medium of instruction is in English. Students are expected to have proficiency in English language, verbal as well as written.

I Eligibility for admission

1. Academic

- a. Candidates who have passed the Higher Secondary Examination of the Board of Higher Secondary Education, Kerala or equivalent examination recognized thereto by KUHS, Thrissur with 50% marks in physics, chemistry, biology and English put together are eligible for admission.
- b. **Eligibility certificate:** Candidates who have passed their qualifying examination from outside the state of Kerala shall produce the certificate of recognition and equivalency of qualifying examination from the Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur. This should be furnished at the time of admission.

2. Age

1. Applicants should have completed 17 years of age on 31st December of that year. No relaxation of the minimum age will be allowed.
2. Self attested copy of relevant page of school record namely S.S.L.C / ICSE/ CBSE certificate showing date of birth/ copy of birth certificate from appropriate authority should be furnished along with the application in proof of age.

III How to apply

1. All candidates seeking admission to B.Sc. Nursing, under Management Quota have to apply directly in the prescribed application form available in the college website <https://taliparambacooperativecollegeofnursing.com> from 12/06/2024 onwards. **Last date for submitting application form is 12/ 07/ 2024 before 5 pm.** Candidates should submit only one application for admission to BSc Nursing. Along with the application all candidates have to attach a self attested copy of the mark list showing the marks in the subjects concerned in their Qualifying Examination.

IV Selection and Admission

1. Selection of the candidates for management seats will be done in the college from among the candidates who have applied online through the college, website based on the marks obtained in the qualifying examination.
2. The Selected candidates will be informed of the date and time of admission
3. The Students shall pay the fees of the first year of the course at the time of admission.
4. The candidates are expected to produce the following documents in original at the time of admission
 - (a) Original admit card ad a copy in case of admission for Government seat.

 - (j) Hepatitis B vaccination certificate
 - (k) COVID Vaccination Certificate
7. If any candidate who is provisionally selected, fails to report to the Principal on or before the specified time and date, his/her selection stands automatically cancelled without any further information, and the seat will be given to the next eligible person in the rank list.

VIII. Special instruction

(a) Ragging

According to the Kerala Prohibition of “ Ragging Act 1998”, ragging means doing of any act by disorderly conduct to a student of an educational institution, which causes or is likely to cause physical or psychological harm or raising apprehension or shame or embarrassment to the student and includes teasing or abusing or playing practical jokes or causing hurt to such students or asking a student to do any act or to perform something which, such student will not in the ordinary course be willing to do.”
