#### OVERVIEW OF CBS NURSING COURSE

B.Sc. Nursing is a four year full-time degree program comprising eight semesters, specified by the Indian Nursing Council (INC) & Kerala Nurses and Midwives Council (KNMC) and affiliated to Kerala University of Health Sciences, (KUHS), which prepares nursing graduates qualified to practice nursing and midwifery in a variety of settings in either public/government or private health-care settings.

• Government Quota: 15 seats (50 % of total seats)

Management Quota: 15 seats (50 % of total seats)

#### ALLOTMENT OF SEATS

#### Government Quota: 15 seats (50 % of total seats)

Government seats are those in which the Director of Medical Education makes allotments. Admission to these seats will be made based on merit. Admission process of allotment to Government merit seats (50%) under Taliparamba Co-operative College of Nursing will be done by the Director, LBS Centre for Science & Technology, under the supervision of the Director of Medical Education. Candidates are requested to visit the official website of the LBS Centre www.lbscentre.kerala.gov.in for details.

#### Management Quota: 15 seats (50 % of total seats)

Other than Government seats (50%), these are the seats against which the Taliparamba Co-operative College of Nursing will make allotment. There will not be any type of reservation in the Management seats. Candidate shall pay the Tuition fees and Special fees, fixed by the Government. The eligibility for admission is the same as for the Government quota and the candidate will be selected on a merit basis. Candidates can apply online through the college website www.taliparambacooperativeco llegeofnursing.com

#### **ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION**

Candidates seeking admission for B.Sc. Nursing courses should fulfill the following:

Candidates who have passed the Higher Secondary examination conducted by the Board of Higher Secondary Education, Kerala, or an examination equivalent thereto as approved by Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur. Should have separate minimum pass mark for Physics, Chemistry and Biology and 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology put together. Applicant should have completed 17 years of age on the 31 December 2025. For the proof of age, a self-attested copy of the relevant page of the school record with date of birth such as SSLC/ CBSE/ ICSE certificate or copy of birth certificate from the appropriate authority should be furnished along with the application form.

Applicants who have passed the qualifying examination from the universities/ boards outside Kerala shall produce the eligibility certificate from KUHS and the Migration certificate from the universities/ boards concerned.

#### DURATION OF THE COURSE

Duration of the B.Sc. Nursing course shall be four years, which is a credit and semester-based program, comprising of eight semesters including an Internship. The maximum period to complete the B.Sc. Nursing course successfully shall not exceed twice the actual duration of the course (Eight years).

#### ADMISSION

Selected candidates will be informed the date and time of interview and admission, in due Course, through the website.

All the selected students should get themselves vaccinated against Hepatitis B before admission. Certificates to the effect should be produced at the time of admission or before the commencement of the course. Physical Fitness Certificate (Certified by a Registered Medical Officer, Government) should be produced at the time of admission or before the commencement of the course.

#### **SELECTION OF CANDIDATES**

- There will be Rank Lists prepared as stated below.
   Rank List will be prepared on the basis of Marks obtained by candidates for Physics, Chemistry,
   Biology put together at the final year of the qualifying examination.
- Resolving of tie while ranking:

In case of a tie in the total marks computed for ranking, candidates with higher marks obtained in Biology (in the final year of the qualifying examination) will be placed higher in the ranking. If the tie still exists, the candidate with higher marks obtained in Chemistry (in the final year of the qualifying examination) will be placed higher in the ranking. If the tie still exists, The candidate with higher marks obtained in Physics (in the final year of the qualifying examination) will be placed higher in the ranking. If the tie still exists, the percentage of total marks for plus one and plus two together and then the percentage of marks in English (in the final year of the qualifying examination) will be considered for breaking the tie. Even after this, if tie remains, the age of the candidate will be taken into account and the older will be placed higher in ranking than the younger. If the tie still persists, tie will be resolved by criteria as decided by the Director of Medical Education.

#### Important Note:

The tuition fee and special fee will be collected as prescribed by the Fee Regulatory Committee (FRC). The proposal for fee revisions (both the tuition fee & special fee) was submitted to the Fee Regulatory Committee (FRC) for approval. If there is any change in the above-mentioned tuition and special fee upon getting the approval from FRC, it will be applicable for all the selected candidates.

If any taxes and levies imposed by the Government will be applicable as extra\*

#### DISCONTINUATION

• Candidates who express their intention not to pursue studies in the Nursing College before the last date fixed for closure of admissions will be eligible for refund of the 1<sup>st</sup> year tuition fee and other fees except admission fee. They will be eligible to get back their original certificates handed over to the College at the time of admission. In the case of students who leave the College midway, the right of the management for liquidated damages, if any, from such students will be determined by the competent "Civil Court."

#### **EXAMINATION**

Regular University Examination is conducted at the end of each semester and supplementary examination as notified by KUHS. Examination fees shall be remitted by the candidate as stipulated by the University & college from time to time

#### ELIGIBILITY FOR APPEARING EXAMINATION

A candidate must have a minimum of 80% attendance in theory and practical in each subject to appear for the University Examination. A minimum of 80% attendance in all the non-exam going subjects in the concerned semester is essential for registering a candidate for the university examination. The candidate must secure 50% marks for internal assessment in theory and practical, wherever applicable to be eligible to appear in the university examination of the subject.

#### **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- 1. Students shall strictly observe professional conduct and high standards of discipline.
- 2. Students should maintain decorum and dignity in the College, Hospital & Hostel.
- 3.As per clause 7 of the Rules and Regulations of the University and Judgment of Honorable Courts regarding the conduct of students on campus, the management has the right to stall organizational activities of students' organization directly or through their member students in campus. An under taking to this effect be given by the students and their parents at the time of admission.
- 4. Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited in the College and Hostel campus. If any incident of ragging occurs, strict action will be taken as per the latest direction of the Hon'ble Supreme Court.
- 5. Use of mobile phones by the students is strictly prohibited in class, clinics and during working hours. If found in use, it will be confiscated.
- 6. Use of drugs/smoking/alcoholism etc. are strictly prohibited in class/compound/clinics /hostel.

  Any violation leads to dismissal from the College.
- 7. Any type of in disciplinary behavior (whistling, passing comments, exhibiting posters, spreading rumors, shouting etc.) towards teachers, other students or staff will not be tolerated and will be subjected to major disciplinary actions.
- 8. Any change in the contact address / telephone number should be informed to the College immediately. The college will not be responsible for any delay /non-receipt of information /communication due to the address change.
- The institution shall not be liable for the delay/loss in communication owing to failure of postal / courier service.
- Each student should report for class / clinical at the specified time. Late comers will not be allowed to attend classes/clinics.
- 11. Students should inform class coordinator / concerned teacher about any inability to attend classes and should submit the leave letter in time. Absenteeism from class / clinics without prior information will be marked as double absence along with other disciplinary actions.

#### UNIFORM

Students are to follow the dress code strictly in class and clinical areas as specified by the institution.
